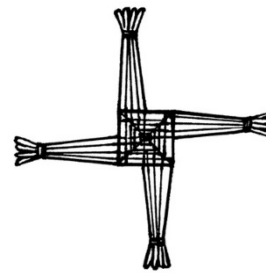


- Online Evening Prayer will take place at 6.00 p.m. today and at 7.00 p.m. on Monday.
